



20 May: Through the hilly Entlebuch

Discover the unknown region between Berne and Lucerne, and pay a visit to the patron saint of travellers.

The hike over the hills leads us through traditional farmland. Isolated farmhouses are scattered throughout the landscape like dice on a green playing field, and tell us stories about the difficult living conditions on the isolated farms until only a few decades ago. Before reaching Schüpfheim we will visit the St. Josephskapelle with its altar of the 14 Good Samaritans, who will bless not only far travelled pilgrims, but also tired hikers.

How to get to Entlebuch

Geneva departure: 6.42 Lausanne departure: 7.20 train to St. Gallen, change at Bern

Bern departure: 8.36 train to Luzern

Zurich departure: 7.32 train to Geneva, change at Bern

Luzern departure: 8.16

Basel departure 7.31 train to Interlaken, change at Berne

Change at Trubschachen to the bus.

Parking is available at Trubschachen railway station. A short train ride will bring you back.

To take with you

- good shoes
- warm clothes (fleece jacket), rain jacket/trousers, umbrella
- 2 litre to drink, lunch and snacks
- sunscreen, sunglasses, hat
- hiking poles (recommended)

Pack as lightly as possible; a small rucksack is easier to carry

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
